

DIAGNOSTIC OF GOVERNANCE OF MARITIME POLICIES

GLOBAL MARITIME GOVERNANCE

Geographical presentation of your region

As per you request we join a map of the region with the requested data. Take note that the length of coastline is 330 Km (plus 250 km of Archipelago). The main extreme meteorological events are: storms, river flooding and coastal area submersion. Population of Tuscany Region: 3.500.000 inhabitants (970.000 on the coast).

Internal Governance and budget

- Do you have a political delegate for maritime affairs?

The integrated maritime policy is headed by the President of the Regional Executive Council on a secondary basis. The new Executive Council of the Region of Tuscany (which took office in May 2010) does not have an appointed Councillor for maritime issues (In 2001 the political appointments were created based on the Coordination of maritime policies which was not renewed in the current legislature). In any case the main policies regarding maritime issues have various appointed political delegates as below:

Regional Department for "Environment and Energy" (protection of the environment and energy: waste cycle management, environmental protection from pollution, reclamation of polluted sites);

Regional Department for "Agriculture" (Agriculture: support for businesses and agricultural and zootechnical production, rural development, forestry, hunting and fishing, agritourism);

Regional Department for "Infrastructures and mobility" (Infrastructures for mobility, logistics, road networks and transport);

Regional Department for "Culture, tourism and commerce" (Tourism and hotel industry);

Regional Department for "Productive Activities, employment and training" (training, orientation and employment).

And/ Or for any MAREMED's theme?

The theme of Integrated Maritime Policies is headed by the President on a secondary basis

The theme of fishing is headed by the Regional Department for "Agriculture";

The theme of pollution is headed by the Regional Department for "Environment and Energy";

The theme of managing littoral and maritime data is headed by the Regional Departments for "Environment and Energy" and "Territory and Urban planning";

The theme of the integrated management of coastal areas is headed by the Regional Department for "Environment and Energy" and "Territory and Urban planning";

The theme of climatic adaptation and change is headed by the Regional Department for "Environment and Energy" and "Territory and Urban planning".

Do you have an official maritime policy identified with a publishable document in the MAREMED website?

Under the current legislature documents dealing with maritime policies have not yet been approved. Under the previous legislature the "Document on integrated policies for the Tuscan coast 2008-2010" was approved with a resolution by the Regional Council (February 12 2008) that defines the coordinating actions for the integrated regional policies for the Tuscan coast, on the basis of the guidelines of regional policies in the sector, and are followed up by the programmed implementation in terms of maritime policies. This document is available only in Italian. In order to implement the above



document the Sea Agenda was prepared; an annual document that presents a complete and updated look at regional policies affecting the Tuscan "sea system", in terms of activities that have been carried out, those that are currently in progress (with relative implementation tools, costs and completion times) and it also indicates which actions are given the priority in each sector, in order to favour an approach that is across-the-board and integrated in the governance of maritime affairs.

- Do you have one or different technical offices for ICZM, Fishing, Coastline management or protection, research cartography and GIS, maritime transports or eventually an office integrating the management of maritime affairs ?

On an administrative level an *ad hoc* sector for integrated maritime policies, namely "Tools for Local and Regional Programming", was created as part of the Presidency of the Directorate General with the aim of guaranteeing a link and coordination between all of the activities linked to maritime issues. A number of sectors in the Directorate Generals are responsible for individual maritime issues (fishing, coastal erosion, agriculture, tourism, energy, etc) and form an internal network that works towards collaboration, the reciprocal exchange of information and participation in numerous project as part of transnational cooperation, cross-border programmes and local political issues. There are specific sectors in the "Territorial, environmental and mobility policies" of the Directorate General that head Integrated Maritime Policy themes: ICZM, fishing, cartography or GIS, transport. Research is transversal and each sector carries out its specific research (there is no single sector dedicated solely to maritime research).

- Do you have a specialized budget or an earmarking action to identify the maritime budget in the different offices and Directions concerned of your region or organization? if yes, amount by year?

Under the current legislature, the sector that heads the Integrated Maritime Policy has drawn up a document (Sea Agenda) which defines the financial outline for the three-year period 2008-2010 for activities linked to the sea. The financial resources were provided by the single sectors heading the various themes linked to maritime policies, and received by the sector that is responsible for integrated maritime policy. For each theme, however, the total amount must be considered an underestimate, especially for transversal sectors (that perform actions in the regional territory as Tourism or Energy), since it is not possible to establish which and how many resources have been employed in the coastal and island area, and in the rest of the territory.





Below is a chart drawn up in 2009 (amounts referring to the year 2010 are, in fact, forecasts) with the identification of the financial source and the sector sustaining the expense.

- Do you have a special mention in your international policy for maritime affairs?

A part of the Regional Development Programme, which will be presented in coming months, will be dedicated to the integrated maritime policy.

Tools of Maritime policies

- Do you have a GIS for coastal management? (You can give a link for MAREMED website)

The data for each theme is managed separately for each sector in regional administration. At the moment there is no portal that receives GIS data for each theme. In the previous legislature a project was





launched to reorganize the territorial and environmental information systems for the region of Tuscany with the aim of rationalizing the existing data banks and those created over the years by the various regional sectors and by the system of Agencies overall. This project has not yet been finalized and, in fact, GIS data can not yet be consulted on any website.

- Do you have a consultation structure with maritime activities representants?

Currently no means of consultation has been set up with representatives of maritime activities on the theme of Integrated Maritime Policy. In the previous legislature (2008 - 2010) the Advisory Board of Tuscany for the sea was established: an organism offering consultation as a go-between between the regional government and local institutions (implemented with the resolution of the Regional Executive Council and formed by the Regional Councillor in charge of coordinating maritime policies, the Mayors of the coastal municipalities and the islands of the Tuscan archipelago, the Presidents of the coastal provinces), with the aim of coordinating the integrated sea policies, verifying implementation status and developing experimental projects. At the moment we do not know if it will be re-instated.

- Do you have a regular consultation event or a regular publication for professional or public?

Not at the moment.

Bottom up governance; for each theme or global maritime policy

- Do you have common tools or formal relations for the management or data exchange with your State?

For the Integrated Maritime Policies there are no formal common or relational tools for the management and exchange of data with the State. As for the smaller islands, the Single Programming Document for the Small Islands (DUPIM) was implemented by the State in collaboration with ANCIM (National Association of the Municipalities of the Small Islands). From 2000 to 2006 this document made it possible to programme and implement development projects for the small islands, known as PIST (Integrated Programmes for territorial Development). As part of the Dupim, the Region of Tuscany is in charge of representing the interests of public and private bodies that adhere to Pist, coordinating the activities and participating in work groups with local institutions, providing financial resources, as well as technical and organizational resources necessary for implementing Pist. In 2008 the new 2008-2010 Dupim was presented indicating the works and relative quantifications. The funds allocated for the year 2010 have yet to be assigned by the Ministry of Economy due to the financial crisis.

- Do you have common tools or formal relations for the management or data exchange with EU?

Not in terms of the Integrated Maritime Policy. Each sector processes theme-related data independently and maintains relations with the European Union under indications provided by their Directorate Generals of reference.

- Do you have common tools or formal relations for the management or data exchange with MAP (Piano d'Azione Mediterraneo) or one of its RAC (Regional Activity Center)?

Not in terms of the Integrated Maritime Policy. There are formal relations regarding certain themes only, for example coastal erosion.

- Did you transfer or have a co-management of the themes of maritime policies with:

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In terms of the Integrated Maritime Policy there is no co-management with other levels of government, nor with professionals nor NGOs. Co-management is prescribed only for certain themes, for example between the Province and the Region of Tuscany for the water Protection Plan and between the Municipalities and the Region of Tuscany for the public maritime domain.

Relations with the research organisations

- Did you create programs of exchange of needs and results with searchers in the maritime themes?

Under the previous period of programming, some research institutes, especially Irpet (Regional Institute for Economic Programming in Tuscany) and Lamma (Laboratory for Environmental Monitoring and Modelling for sustainable development) have performed research and studies on topics linked to the Integrated Maritime Policy.

- Do you work in any way with private or public research institutions (private companies, universities, etc...)

Below is a list of the main institutions collaborating with the Region of Tuscany regarding the management of maritime affairs.

Irpet (Regional Institute For the Economic Programming in Tuscany): is responsible for the structural interpretation of the economic and social system of Tuscany, and for the past while also the economic situation, and produces an Annual report on the Tuscan economy and a series of Sectorial Reports (exportation, tourism, etc).

Arpat (Regional Agency for the Environmental Protection of Tuscany): active since 1996, through a network of Provincial Departments and Sub-provincial Services in the regional territory, Arpat guarantees the implementation of regional guidelines in the field of environmental prevention and protection.

Lamma (Laboratory for Environmental Monitoring and Modelling for sustainable development): founded in 1997 with the aim of creating an interface between the world of the institutions, elements of scientific and technologic excellence, the industry and the various structures operating in the sectors of meteorology, climatology, geographic information systems (GIS) and geology. The agency is responsible for research and studies in the field of modelling the dispersion of pollutants in the atmosphere, anemology studies for eolic purpose, marine and oceanographic modelling, controlling pollutants and the state of health of the sea, by monitoring marine plant life. **Universities** national and international.

Network of institutes for surveyors of the Tuscan coast, (I.GE.CO, Coastal Surveyor Institutes). Thanks to a special convention stipulated with the region of Tuscany, the network partakes in the activities of the cross border project known as PERLA, with the aim of improving accessibility, use and safety of the public access points to the seaside along the Tuscan coast. The Institutes run monitoring systems, research on the territory and catalogue and re-process the data, with the aim of defining the risks linked to accessibility and identifying measures to eliminate and/or reduce the risk and the overall improvement of the use of public access-ways to the seaside.





CNR (National Research Council) has the task of performing, promoting, providing, transferring and improving research activity in the main sectors of the development of knowledge and its applications for scientific, technologic, economic and social development.

THEMATIC ISSUES; GOVERNANCE OF FISHING

Internal Governance and budget

- Do you have a political delegate specially dedicated to fishing policy?

Fishing issues are covered by the agriculture policy. The political representative for fishing is the Regional Councillor for Agriculture.

- Do you have an official fishing policy identified with a publishable document in a website?

In the Region of Tuscany we have a specific regional law governing maritime fishing (Regional Law 66/2005 and successive amendments and integrations "Regulations for maritime fishing activities and actions in support of maritime fishing and aquaculture"), of which the implementing regulations are in a phase of prearrangement, with the exception of regulations regarding fishing and fish tourism, which are already re-included in the regional law (the documents are already published on the regional website).

- What is your office dedicated to fishing policy?

Professional sea fishing and sport sea fishing are covered directly by the "Agricultural Zootechnical Productions" sector. Lacking specific regulations, which are currently being drawn up, the matter is governed on a national level by the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry.

Sport fishing in inland waters is covered by the "Agri-environmental policies, Wildlife and Hunting policies and Amateur Fishing" sector.

Both sectors belong to the Coordinating Area of "Rural Development" (Regional department of Agriculture and Forestry).

- Do you have a specialized budget for fishing policy?

We have regional resources amounting to approximately 1.400.000 €year at our disposal.

The Region of Tuscany does not have its own GIS database dedicated to fishing. There is a national system that the region can access as needed.

The Regional Advisory Commission for Fishing and Aquaculture instituted in the Region of Tuscany is composed of public and private bodies.

- Do you have a regular consultation event on fishing theme or a regular publication for professional or public?

The Regional Advisory Commission for Fishing and Aquaculture convenes on request of the participating bodies to consult on specific problems.





On a national level there is the National Advisory Commission, that examines all national acts regarding fishing.

There is a national system designed to gather data on fishing and aquaculture which is implemented by the Ministry for Agricultural and Forestry Policies (S.I.P.A.). The Region of Tuscany, along with the other regions, supplies this system with data.

The Region of Tuscany interacts with the European Union through its participation in the CIM (Intermediterranean Commission) group of the CRPM (Conference of Peripheral Maritime Regions of Europe), as well as through the national surveillance committee for the implementation of the FEP

Regulations regarding fishing activities are enforced at a regional level through the implementing regulations of Regional Law 66/05. Lacking these regulations and awaiting their regional issue, we refer to the national law.

The implementation of actions is delegated to the Provinces, as per RL 66/05.

The Region, furthermore, interacts with trade associations which are represented at a regional level.

Relations with the research organisations

- Did you create programs of exchange of needs and results with searchers in the fishing themes? Do you work in any way with private or public research institutions (private companies, universities, etc.)

The Region of Tuscany, with regard to fishing, collaborates on a regional level, with CIBM (Interuniversity Consortium for Applied Marine Biology) and ARPAT, "Sea" section. It also maintains relations with other bodies that operate on a national scale and with universities.





Transnational governance;

The Region of Tuscany participates in the "Intermediterranean Commission" (CIM) and the work group "Aquamarina" which is part of CRPM.

The Region of Tuscany heads the strategic project "MARTE+" (O.P. Italy-France Maritime 2007-2013). The project deals with agricultural and fishing issues. The effects of sustainability at the end of the project can not be assessed as it is still in progress.

We currently share an initial hypothesis of collaboration with the Region of Liguria, aimed at building an interregional fishing district.
