Definition

Pesca tourism is the name given to taking passengers on board a fishing vessel in order to present the fishing trade and the marine environment



Regulations

The Decree of the 23 November 1987 on Ship Safety, supplemented by the Decree of the 24 November 2008 (Divisions 226 and 227 of the appended Regulations)

Minutes of the Regional Safety Commission no.269/19: Pesca tourism of the 12 May 2011



Life rafts, number of passengers, seats, stability, sanitation/habitability, Official Prevention Document, passenger/crew members, operations, radio, medical supplies, etc.

The Haute Corse Direction Départemental des Territoires et de la Mer: draft of the "staffing decisions for 'pesca tourism'" which includes various terms relating to the safety of ships, passengers, and, depending on weather conditions (wind strength and direction), the sites to be used.






The island: 4 prud'homies

Corsica has a non-industrial fleet

The fleet's average boat size is 10 m

1 043 km of coastline for the whole of the island's coast,





On a 0 to 3 nautical mile coastal strip


These excursions are for the day or half-day

The average age of fishermen is about 50






The whole fleet was approached by the Corsica CRPMEM




Maremed Seminar – on fishing






Construction of a catamaran fishing boat, the Pesca 1100, in 2010




11 metre long catamaran in aluminium designed for fishing (nets and long-lines)

Can carry 12 passengers (secure area, seats, toilets, etc.)



Sails can be used for propulsion




Half day excursions

From 7am to $12pm = 40 \in /pers$.


In the Bouches de Bonifacio Nature Reserve

Very popular

Very little advertising: mainly word of mouth and Bonifacio tourist office
